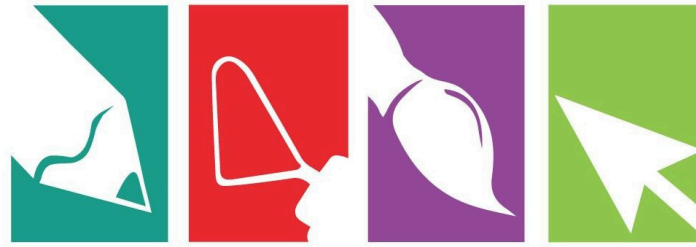


March is Youth Art Month!
